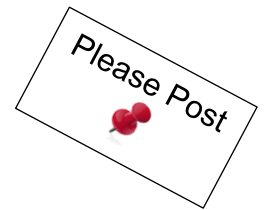

EC Section 13126 requires LEAs to make a concerted effort to notify parents of the purpose of the report cards and to ensure that all parents receive a copy of the report card in an easy-to-read and understandable format.
